What Is an Off-Market Property?

An off-market property — often called a 'pocket listing' — is a home that is for sale but is not publicly advertised on the MLS, Zillow, or Realtor.com. Sellers of ultra-luxury homes frequently choose this route for three key reasons:

- Privacy: High-profile sellers prefer to keep personal transitions out of the public eye.
- Exclusivity: By limiting exposure, the property retains an aura of rarity that commands premium pricing.
- Qualified Buyers Only: Off-market sales ensure that only serious, financially vetted buyers are considered.

For buyers, gaining access to this hidden inventory is the key to finding the perfect property without engaging in public bidding wars — or missing out entirely.
